Affordable Transportation Options in the District

Washington, DC is heavily invested in providing affordable, alternative transportation options to residents across all eight wards of the city, regardless of income. To help meet that goal, DC has a number of transportation programs in place that provide discounted access to Capital Bikeshare, dockless vehicles such as scooters, and others.



Affordable

Special discount programs are available for eligible individuals to use Capital Bikeshare, dockless bikes or scooters, and the Metro.



Accessible

You can easily find a dockless bike or scooter, ride Capital Bikeshare, or Metro across all eight wards of the District.

Choosing active transportation, like biking or walking, can contribute to your daily exercise and a healthier lifestyle.

CAPITAL BIKESHARE

Capital Bikeshare for All allows those who qualify for certain state or federal assistance programs (SNAP, TANF, etc.) to sign up for Capital Bikeshare online or join through a Community Partner. If eligible, you can get an annual membership for just \$5!

SCOOTERS

All scooter operators offer a low-income customer plan to provide access to dockless bikes and scooters. If eligible, you can get **FREE** unlimited 30-minute trips.

Revel, DC's only electric moped operator, has an Access Program that offers a 40% discount on all rides to individuals who participate in local, state, or federal assistance programs. Revel will also credit \$25 to anyone who enrolls in their Access Program.
