

# Commercial Vehicle Loading Zones

Require a Permit or Meter Payment

## To Load/Unload a Commercial Vehicle in a Loading Zone You Must:

- Display an Annual or Daily Permit, or
- Pay-by-Cell

## Ways to Pay:

### Annual or Daily Permit

Allows parking at commercial vehicle loading zones during designated hours for up to two hours, and parking in metered spaces between 10AM—2PM. Permits can be bought at <https://tops.ddot.dc.gov/>

**PAY-BY-CELL** If you choose not to purchase a permit, follow the instructions on the loading zone signage to pay for the space via ParkMobile.

## How much Does it Cost?

**Annual Permit**  
(\$323)

**Daily Permit**  
(\$25)

**PAY-BY-CELL**  
(\$2.30+/Hour)

# Commercial Vehicle Loading Zones

## Program Guidelines & Penalties

### Operators Should:

- Visit DDOT's Truck & Bus Map to find loading zones
- Check signage for day/hour/time restrictions
- Ensure that all permits and decals are visible
- Not park for longer than time limit on signage
- Pay-by-cell for time needed if without a permit

### Operators Will Be Ticketed If:

- No permit is displayed, or no mobile payment is made (\$50)
- Permit is expired or not properly displayed (\$50)
- Commercial vehicle stays longer than time limit (\$50)
