BLUE / YELLOW LINE STATION CLOSURES TOOLKIT FOR RIDERS

September - May 2023

WHAT IS THE CONSTRUCTION PROJECT?

The Washington Metropolitan Area Transportation Association (WMATA) will rehabilitate the Yellow Line tunnel and bridge between Pentagon and L'Enfant Plaza stations and connect the new Potomac Yard Station to the mainline rail system.

During Phase I, six stations south of Ronald Reagan National Airport (DCA) on the Yellow and Blue Lines will be closed until October 22, 2022. The Blue or Green Lines will serve Yellow Line stations north of DCA.

During Phase II, all stations will reopen, but the Yellow Line tunnel near L'Enfant Plaza Station and the bridge across the Potomac River will close from October 23, 2022, to May 2023. The Blue or Green Lines will serve all Yellow Line stations.





All Yellow Line stations will be served by the Blue or Green Lines





BUS

Phase I

DASH Bus provides fare-FREE service within the city of Alexandria and connects with Metrobus, Metrorail, VRE, and all local bus systems. The "DASH" name symbolizes their commitment to the citizens of Alexandria -- Driving Alexandria Safely Home.

- » Line 35 Service between Van Dorn Metro, Yoakum Pkwy, Beauregard St, and Pentagon Metro
- » Line 103 Service between Braddock Metro, Russell Rd, Glebe Rd, and Pentagon Metro
- » Line 104 Service between Braddock Metro, Cameron Mills Dr, Parkfairfax, and Pentagon Metro

Fairfax Connector is the largest local bus system in Northern Virginia transporting about 30,000 residents on 91 routes daily.

- » Routes 393/394 Service between Saratoga Shopping Center, Saratoga Park & Ride, Backlick North Park & Ride, Mark Center, and Pentagon Metro Station
- » Routes 395/396 Service between Gambrill Road Park & Ride, Backlick North Park & Ride, and Pentagon Metro Station

OmniRide/PRTC is a public transportation agency located in the Prince William area that provides a host of travel options in Northern Virginia. OmniRide operates express and local bus service in neighborhoods surrounded by the I-95 and I-66 corridors.

- » Route D-100 Service between Dale City and Downtown Washington
- » Route L-100 Service between Lake Ridge and Downtown Washington
- » Route D-200 Service between Dale City, Pentagon, and Rosslyn/Ballston
- » Route L-200 Service between Lake Ridge, Pentagon, and Crystal City
- » Route D-300 Service between Dale City, Pentagon, and Washington Navy Yard
- » RS South Route 1– Service between Triangle, Dumfries, Woodbridge, Pentagon, and Downtown Washington
- » MC Montclair Service between Montclair, Pentagon, and Downtown Washington





OPTIONS TO/FROM DC

BIKING

CAPITAL BIKESHARE single trip rates start at \$1 to unlock + \$0.05/min for a classic bike and \$0.15/min for an ebike. Day passes are \$8/day for unlimited 45 min rides on a classic bike and \$0.10/min on ebikes.

Use a personal bike to get to your nearest open Metrorail station where secure bike parking is available. You can also bring your bike on board the Metrorail at any time.

SCOOTERS AND DOCKLESS BIKES are currently available in the District and Northern Virginia. Scooters and dockless bikes can easily be located and unlocked using the provider's mobile app.

- » Northern Virginia Bird, Lime, Spin (Dockless operators may vary by jurisdiction.)

WASHINGTON AREA BICYCLISTS ASSOCIATION (WABA) offers courses for bicyclists of all skill levels to help adults ride more comfortably and confidently. All Capital Bikeshare members can access WABA classes for free.

RAIL

VRE – The Virginia Railway Express (VRE) service is available at Franconia-Springfield, King St-Old Town (VRE Station Alexandria), Crystal City, and L'Enfant Plaza Metro stations. **VRE will offer FREE rides** systemwide in September and between select stops in October.



TRAILS

Trails run between the District and Virginia with Mount Vernon Trail and Rock Creek Trail being highly accessible options. Mount Vernon Trail is an 18-mile paved multi-use trail that stretches from George Washington's Mount Vernon Estate to Theodore Roosevelt Island, connecting with regional trails.

Rock Creek Trail is an 8.5 mile asphalt/dirt multi-use trail with multiple end points in DC. Each of these trails are intended for shared use by a variety of groups (bicyclists, pedestrians, and joggers) and can be used as a commuter route. Learn more at **goDCgo.com/bike**.



RIDESHARING

The Vanpool Alliance helps riders find vanpools that start or terminate in Northern VA through their free Vanpool Finder service. **vanpoolalliance.org**

Commuter Connections' Ridematching program will match commuters with a carpool or vanpool – reducing road congestion and freeing up parking. <u>commuterconnections.org</u>

Sluglines assists drivers bound on the I-395/I-95 and I-66 corridors by reaching the HOV passenger requirements. Riders receive a free ride. Find pick-up and drop-off locations at <u>sluglines.com</u>.

uberPOOL, Lyft Line, and Via allow commuters to share the ride with others in the same direction and pay less for your trip. Grab a ride using the provider's mobile app.

eRideShare, Sameride, and Waze Carpool are mobile apps that connect commuters going the same way in DC and Virginia.

Taxis can be easily located and hailed around the Northern Virginia area with 24-hour dispatch service.

CARSHARING

Zipcar allows members to reserve and rent a car for as little as an hour and never requires members to pay for gas. <u>zipcar.com/washington-dc</u>

TELEWORK & HYBRID SCHEDULES

Telework is a work arrangement in which employees can work from home or an alternate location and do not have to commute to their usual place of employment. A hybrid schedule is where employees telework part of the week and are in office the rest of the week. Hybrid polices range from teleworking 1 day a week to 4 days a week.

By establishing a telework policy or hybrid schedule during the platform closures, employees are able to maximize productivity while allowing for business continuity. Ask your employer about a telework or hybrid arrangement.

FLEXIBLE SCHEDULE

Instead of requiring employees to report to work during standard hours, employees can avoid peak commute hours by implementing flexible work options. Ask your employer about non-traditional flexible options by either developing non-peak schedules for specific teams who consistently work together or by establishing midday core hours for all employees so meetings can be held regardless of start or end times.
