### TIDAL BASIN WELCOME AREA & ANA STAGE

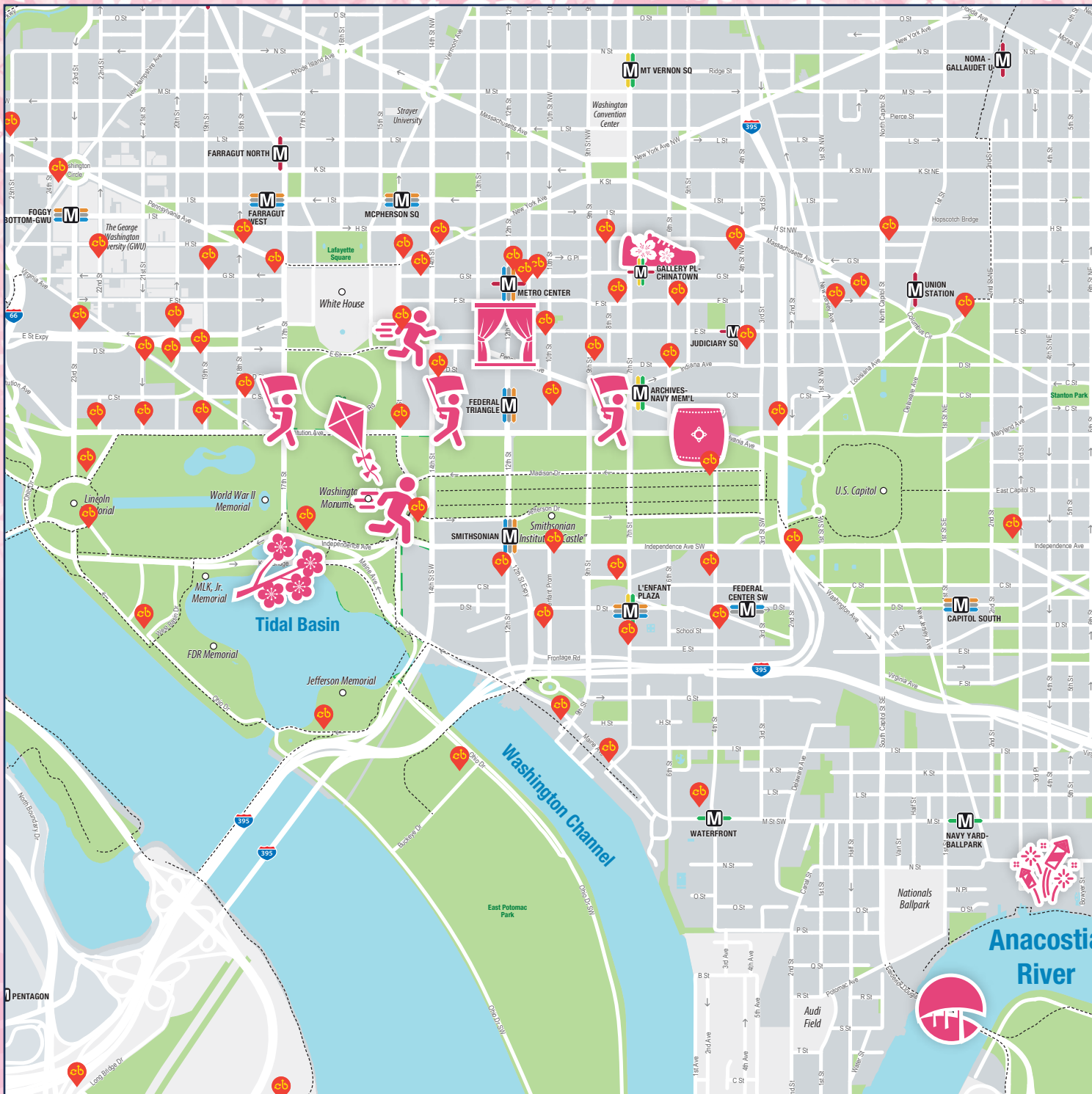
