Washington, DC is served by three major airports—Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport (DCA), Dulles International Airport (IAD), and Baltimore/Washington International Thurgood Marshall Airport (BWI), all of which are well connected by transit, bikeshare, and shuttle options, making travel to and from the region easy and reliable.

Union Station serves as a central transportation hub, offering access to Metro, Amtrak, MARC, VRE, buses, and bikeshare, which enables travelers to reach destinations throughout the DMV and beyond quickly.

Rides start at \$2.25. SmarTrip® cards, mobile SmarTrip® payments, and credit/debit cards are accepted.

One-way fares are \$2.00 for adults, \$1.00 for seniors, and a day pass is \$4.60. Payments can be made using the Charm pass app or the station's vending machine.

Rail Services

- Metrorail: Greenbelt Station ●
- MARC Train: Penn Line, Connects BWI Rail Station to Union Station (DC)
- Amtrak: Connects from BWI Rail Station & New Carrollton to Union Station





Bus Services

- MTA Local Link - Route 75: Services Patapsco Light Rail Station, Arundel Mills Mall, and surrounding areas (24/7 service)
- MTA Commuter Bus - Route 201: Connects to Gaithersburg Park & Ride, Shady Grove Metro Station, Burtonsville, and Arundel Mills (limited express weekday service)
- MTA Light Rail Link: Connects to Downtown Baltimore, Timonium, and Hunt Valley
- BWI Courtesy Rail Shuttle: Runs between BWI terminal and MARC/Amtrak rail station, every 10-15 minutes)
