SERVICE IMPACTS & STATION CLOSURES TOOLKIT FOR RIDERS

June 1 - August 31, 2024

WHAT IS THE CONSTRUCTION PROJECT?

The Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority (WMATA)'s Red Line closure was planned in coordination with the Maryland Transit Administration's Purple Line project. A new mezzanine will be built to connect the Paul S. Sarbanes Transit Center and the future Purple Line Station to Metro's Silver Spring platform, enhancing connections for Metro, MARC Train, and bus customers. This requires the closure of the Silver Spring Station for several months. As a result, Metro grouped together additional maintenance, repairs, and improvements on the Red Line to be completed at the same time. This allows Metro to get the work done over three months, rather than more than eight months of weekend closures and disruptions if the work were done individually in shorter segments.


RD No **Red Line** service between Glenmont and Takoma.

June 30 to August 31, 2024

RD No **Red Line** service between Glenmont and Silver Spring. Takoma Station will reopen.

Customers traveling between the closed stations and Takoma should use the local shuttle bus or the Red Line via Fort Totten.


OPTIONS TO/FROM METRORAIL

SHUTTLES

There will be free local, express, and limited-stop shuttles during Metrorail operating hours.

Local Service: Local service approximately every 4-8 minutes between Wheaton, Forest Glen, Takoma, and Fort Totten.

- » Glenmont Boards at Bus Bay F.
- » Wheaton Southbound service boards at Bus Bay T1. Northbound service boards at Bus Bay T3.
- » Forest Glen Southbound service boards at Bus Bay F. Northbound service boards at Bus Bay G.
- » Silver Spring Southbound service boards at Bus Bay 116. Northbound service boards at Bus Bay 115.
- » Takoma Southbound service boards at Bus Bay F. Northbound service boards at Bus Bay E.
- » Fort Totten Boards at Bus Bay A.





OPTIONS TO/FROM METRORAIL

SHUTTLES

Limited Service: Limited-stop service approximately every 4-8 minutes.

Limited 1: Limited-stop service between Glenmont, Wheaten, and Fort Totten. Limited 2: Limited-stop service between Forest Glen, Silver Spring, and Fort Totten.

- » Glenmont Limited 1 service boards at Bus Bay E.
- » Wheaton Southbound Limited 1 service boards at Bus Bay T2. Northbound Limited 1 service boards at Bus Bay T3.
- » Forest Glen Southbound Limited 2 service boards at Bus Bay D. No Northbound Limited Service.
- » Silver Spring Southbound Limited 2 service boards at Bus Bay 116. Northbound Limited 2 service boards at Bus Bay 115.
- » Fort Totten Northbound Limited 1 service boards at Bus Bay C. Northbound Limited 2 service boards at Bus Bay B.

Express Service: Weekdays only. Express service every 4-8 minutes between Silver Spring and Metro Center.

» Silver Spring – Express service to Metro Center boards at Bus Bay 117

Customers at the closed stations who use Metro's Park & Ride facilities may whish to park at other Red Line or Green Line stations, including:

- » Green Line Greenbelt, College Park U of MD, Hyattsville Crossing

MARC TRAIN

Brunswick Line: Service to and from Rockville, Garret Park, Kensington, Silver Spring, and Union Station. <u>Learn more</u>.

BUS

METROBUS provides multiple routes that connect District, Maryland, and Virginia residents to nearby Metrorail stations. Fares start at \$2, cash or SmarTrip[®] card, or download the SmarTrip[®] app for a contactless way to pay.

Glenmont

» Y2, Y7, Y8 – Service between Medstar Montgomery Medical Center and Silver Spring Station.

Wheaton

- » Q2, Q4 Service between Rockville/Shady Grove and Silver Spring stations.
- » Y2, Y7, Y8 Service between Medstar Montgomery Medical Center and Silver Spring Station.

Forest Glen

- » Q2, Q4 Service between Shady Grove and Silver Spring stations. Stops on Georgia Ave at Forest Glen Rd.
- » Y2, Y7, Y8 Service between Medstar Montgomery Medical Center and Silver Spring Station. Stops on Georgia Ave at Forest Glen Rd.

OPTIONS TO/FROM DC

BIKING

CAPITAL BIKESHARE single trip rates start at \$1 to unlock + \$0.05/min for a classic bike and \$0.15/min for an ebike. Day passes are \$8/day for unlimited 45 min rides on a classic bike and \$0.10/min on ebikes.

Capital Bikeshare stations are available at most Metrorail stations. Find a Capital Bikeshare station near you.

Use a personal bike to get to your nearest open Metrorail station where secure bike parking is available. You can also bring your bike on board the Metrorail at any time.

SCOOTERS AND DOCKLESS BIKES are currently available in the District. Scooters and dockless bikes can easily be located and unlocked using the provider's mobile app.

RIDESHARING

Commuter Connections' Ridematching program will match commuters with a carpool or vanpool – reducing road congestion and freeing up parking. **commuterconnections.org**

uberPOOL and Via allow commuters to share the ride with others in the same direction and pay less for your trip. Grab a ride using the provider's mobile app.

eRideShare and Sameride are mobile apps that connect commuters going the same way in DC.

Taxis can be easily located and hailed around the District area with 24-hour dispatch service.

CARSHARING

Zipcar allows members to reserve and rent a car for as little as an hour and never requires members to pay for gas. **<u>zipcar.com/washington-dc</u>**.

ADDITIONAL OPTIONS



TELEWORK & HYBRID SCHEDULES

Telework is a work arrangement in which employees can work from home or an alternate location and do not have to commute to their usual place of employment. A hybrid schedule is where employees telework part of the week and are in office the rest of the week. Hybrid polices range from teleworking 1 day a week to 4 days a week.

By establishing a telework policy or hybrid schedule during the platform closures, employees are able to maximize productivity while allowing for business continuity. Ask your employer about a telework or hybrid arrangement.

FLEXIBLE SCHEDULE

Instead of requiring employees to report to work during standard hours, employees can avoid peak commute hours by implementing flexible work options. Ask your employer about non-traditional flexible options by either developing non-peak schedules for specific teams who consistently work together or by establishing midday core hours for all employees so meetings can be held regardless of start or end times.


